

COTSWOLD CLASSIC CAR RUN & MUSIC WEEKEND

SATURDAY 6th SEPTEMBER 2008

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The event is open to any classic car, sports car, kit or replica which is road legal.
2. Entries will be accepted from owners of vehicles conforming to these regulations. An "Entrant" for the purpose of these Regulations, need not be a member of any motor club but must be the legal owner, or be appointed as the representative of, a museum, trust, collection or company having legal ownership of the vehicle. The Entrant and driver (if different) must sign the Entry Form.
3. The driver shall be the person whose name appears on the Entry Form (or navigator if you wish to share the driving provided the person is named and insured). No other person may drive on this event.
4. Entries open with the publication of these Rules & Regulations.
5. Entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis, but the Organisers reserve the right of selection to produce a balanced entry. Entries will only be accepted if accompanied by the entry fee. Only one entry per entry form is permitted. If more than one vehicle is to be entered then a separate entry form is required for each vehicle. Photocopies ARE acceptable.
6. The entry fee for all vehicles is £240.00. The entry fee includes overnight accommodation at Heythrop Park, dinner with wine and live music, private reception, full English breakfast and use of all leisure facilities all weekend for driver & navigator only. Additional passengers pay £180 based on 2 people sharing to include as above.
7. If an entry is cancelled by the Participant, the entry will only be refunded if the cancellation is notified in writing more than one calendar month before the event (i.e. before 6th August 2008). Likewise, should an entrant wish to change the vehicle entered, this must be notified in writing no later than one week before the event .
8. If the Cotswold Classic Car Run & Music Weekend is cancelled by the organisers due to conditions beyond their control a full refund of the entry fee paid will be paid to the entrant. All details correct at time of going to print. The Organisers reserve the right to make changes if circumstances so dictate.
9. Any entrant who fails to take up their entry on the day without giving prior notice, or a written explanation within 7 days of the event, may be excluded from the following years event.
10. The Start Point will be Buscot Park, Faringdon, Oxon. Vehicles will leave at 30 second intervals starting at 0930 Start numbers and check in times will be issued within 10 days of the run date with the entrants final instructions. Entrants may indicate an early or late start time, but the Organisers cannot guarantee a specific time.
11. A comprehensive route book will be issued at the Start Point. Enough time should be allocated for participants to study the route book prior to departure. Greenwood Exhibitions accept no responsibility for last minute changes to the route published due to unforeseen circumstances.
12. The Finish will be Heythrop Park, where drivers will park in their dedicated display area.
13. Tender vehicles (i.e. transporters and trailers only, NOT private cars) should only be used if absolutely necessary. Any tender observed travelling less than 100 yards behind ANY entry may result in its own entry being excluded from the following years event. Each tender vehicle must display an official "Tender" vehicle pass which will be issued with the Final Instructions upon written request. Tender vehicles parking will be available at both start point and in a designated area on Heythrop Park. Drivers and passengers of tender vehicles will not be permitted free entry to the stopping points and their vehicles will not be admitted to any special parking area for Run participants.
14. All Entrants will receive a commemorative rally plate for their participating vehicle. This plate will be numbered and MUST be affixed to the vehicle prior to entry to Buscot Park. All entrants participating will receive one Certificate of Participation in the name of the Driver. Participants may order (in advance) any number of additional individual Certificates of Participation for navigator and passengers - details must be given on the entry form. The cost for each additional Certificate is £4.50. All Entrants will also receive one Free photograph.
15. Entry vehicles must hold a valid and current road licence/tax were applicable, a current MOT Certificate and carry appropriate insurance to cover the driver (and named co-driver) the vehicle and the use of the vehicle for the event on the date of the event. Participants should be aware that they are responsible for the driving conduct of their vehicle at all times and must undertake to observe the Road Traffic Acts in all respects at all times on both public highway and private property.
16. Overtaking on public roads IS allowed in accordance with the Road Traffic Acts. The Cotswold Classic Car Run is a Touring Assembly organised by GREENWOOD EXHIBITIONS. The run is joining an existing event organised by Heythrop Park. Any alterations to the Heythrop Park event are their responsibility.
